REPORTS

REGISTRAR: The registrar submitted a report showing the registration to date. She will be unavailable as of the dates given to the registrars. Reminder to Fig Garden to get their recreational rosters in. These must be signed for the teams to play in McValley Cup. Please use only the new forms. Any others should be destroyed.

TREASURER: No report. The end of the year report will be available by next meeting.

COACHING: The nominations for Coach of the Year are due by October 15. None have been received so far. Please send in ASAP. Fees have been raised for coaching clinics. The F Clinic must have \$600. up front from the league to cover \$35.00 per coach. The E Clinic must have \$750.00 up front to cover the \$45.00 fee per coach and the E/D Clinic will be \$125.00 per coach. Red cards are down for coaches and players this season so far.

ODP: Jonathon Petty has been seated as ODP Chair for CYSA. Congratulations!!!!
The 1990 boys had a scramble with some glitches but it is working out. Girls will play next weekend. The 1989 boys, Steven Alvarado and Jesus Santiago from Clovis, have been asked back. Next year the committee will try something new and different within the program.

REFEREES: Mick submitted a written report. The new publication, Game Card, went out to all referees with the payroll. There was also a written report on the mentoring clinic. Hope this will help the young referees. Referee registration is down about 50%.

STATE CUP: Last reminder, State Cup applications must be in the CYSA office by November 1. List your roster as it is now. Adds can be done later.

TOURNAMENTS: John attended two meetings. Applications to host a tournament should be received this week. Deadline is November 1 to the District. Fees have been raised to \$400. for 49 or more teams and \$300 for tournaments up to 48 teams. The rules will be before the Board of Directors in November. These should be done electronically. Please use separate envelopes for each tournament.

D7PP: John thanked Mick Walker (Referees) for being on the committee. He has helped with the problems. Field Marshalls must be visible and on each field to help the referees. Visibility cures or prevents the problems. Statements for fines for non-compliance are being sent to the leagues. Please make sure that the referees get the game cards into the office in a timely manner.

OLD BUSINESS: The proposal from Clovis to amend the All Star rules was brought forth. They would like to add more teams for leagues that have more than 4000 registered players. Discussion was held on the “picking” of teams, without tryouts and whether we should have the All Star program.
