REPORTS

REGISTRAR: Player count to date is 21,734. Registrars are scheduled to meet with Brian Siwy from CYSA this weekend. The District VII registrars meeting will be held April 4th and 6th. Two leagues did not sign up for the WinReg session. Question was asked as to why counts are down. Brian is doing a count. Some leagues are not yet on 4.0 and they are sent back.

TREASURER: Profit & Loss statement was in all mailboxes. There were no comments or questions.

STATE CUP: Finals were held for the younger group, some on artificial turf. Winners were: U-11B DeAnza, U-11 G Central Valley Chili Peppers, U-12 B Santa Clara Sporting, U-12 G Mustang Rampage, U-13 B Stockton Monarchs, U-13 G Mustang Earthquakes.

ODP: A written report was submitted by Jonathan. Changes are being made in the format to select pool players.

TOURNAMENTS: The tournament applications were sent to the CYSA BOD for approval. Some corrections were made. They should have a tournament booklet to be handed out at the AGM. John must see a draft roster before he will be able to approve early tournament applications. The tournament directors workshop will be held on April 22/23. Question was asked about tournaments that were cancelled and their status. He explained that their status would remain the same and explained the P status.

REFEREE: Mick submitted a written report. We sent three referees to do the younger group finals for State Cup. Referee evaluations were positive. The May D7 meeting will be for league referee coordinators. Reminded all leagues to bring their coordinators.

TOP SOCCER: Top program is now in baseball. They are getting more kids in, 45 new kids signed up. Gary will be doing a presentation at the AGM. The "Texas hold 'em" tournament brought in about \$4000 and donations are still coming in.

Gloria reported on American Cup. Madera team was a winner in the U-16 boys. They had a problem with one team, coaches and players.

D7PP: John thanked Mick for making the referees accountable. Be careful when you pick age group hosting. Make sure you have referees proper for that age group and proper fields. Reiterated again that it is the leagues responsibility to put their teams in the proper division.

DISTRICT COMMISSIONER'S REPORT: All league affiliations are in with the exception of Sanger.

CYSA Equipment show and AGM will be held March 18/19 in Sacramento.

Pete Sofie was elected 1st Vice Chairman.

April D7 meeting will be President's Roundtable, May will be Referee workshop, June will be coaching.

GOOD OF THE GAME: Clovis held a Division III tournament and commented that they were proud of the District 7 teams.

ODP has a team going to National.
