## **REPORTS**

**REGISTRAR:** The registrar submitted a written report on registration from the leagues for this season.

**TREASURER:** No report. Included in the mail boxes was an office report for the fiscal year. An office budget was also submitted by Linda.

**ODP:** A written report was submitted by Jonathan with a reminder of the last two camp dates.

**TOURNAMENTS:** The tournament directors workshop was held in Fremont. Attendees from District VII were Lemoore, Fresno Metro, Fig Garden and South Valley. John would like to get this incorporated with the President's Round Table. He would like to keep other tournaments from requesting more teams because in the long run it hurts District VII Tournaments. He votes no on all the requests even though he is outvoted. Reminder to apply to tournaments on time and to put return addresses on their envelopes.

**COACHING:** A written report was submitted. Gary W. spoke on licensing of coaches. Clay wants all league coaches to have an "F" license by their second year of coaching. He asked that the leagues take the proposal back to their leagues for comments. Discussion was held on mandatory licensing. Pre F course is 150.00. John would like a separate coaching policy written up before it is submitted to the leagues.

**REFEREE:** Mick submitted a written report. Linda stated that there is a problem with the written reports not getting to the appropriate person. All referees did well at the Regionals. Mike Zapata has been selected to referee at the National Championships. Fliers have gone out for the mandatory District League referee clinics.
