REPORTS

Darrellyn thanked the teams for participation. She needs teams in the U-6,U-8 and U-10 groups for the Hanford and Los Banos tournaments. She presented Linda with a picture of an angel holding a heart to show their appreciation for her help over the years. Gary Waltz was also presented with a certificate for the Top Soccer group.

TREASURER: No report

REGISTRAR: As of October 16,2006, District VII has over 23,000 players registered. Registrars have done a good job,

STATE CUP: Draw will be held this weekend in Pleasanton for the younger group. There are 381 teams entered for the younger group and 531 for the older age groups.

ODP: Letters have been sent to the players that will come back in March.

TOURNAMENTS: All applications to host tournaments must be complete. All tournament reports must be sent in a timely manner or they will not be approved. Recreational tournaments must send in their rules, which must be stamped and approved.

SPL: All home league games are done. The North South Shootout games will be held at the Regional Sports Park on November 11/12.

REFEREES: Mick's written report has not been disseminated. There will be an upgrade clinic for grades 7,6 and 5 at Fresno City College. Mike Zapata has been selected to referee at the Regionals in Las Vegas. USSF registration is going on now. If you wish to register on-line, go to cnra.net then to registration. Issues with the game cards have shown improvement. Leagues may apply to hold referee clinics after April 1.

TOP SOCCER: They have two more weeks of league play and then will have parent games. They had 92 kids participating, We are winding down. Linda reported that CYSA will send a string back pack and a hat to all participants.

D7PP: League play started off good but now have about 240 red cards for players and 2 coaches. HSY has the majority, Don Hawkins has 7 or 8. Field marshals have not been present at all sites. A comment was made that the coaches do not control their players. They need to teach sportsmanship and control. Question was asked about allowing red carded coaches to come to games while on suspension. Each league should monitor their coaches.

OLD BUSINESS: All Star applications are due December 1. Applications to host are due Nov. 15. Clovis, Madera, Valley and Roosevelt have submitted their applications.

COMMISSIONER'S REPORT: Mark your calendar for the CYSA AGM in February. It will be held in Santa Clara. There were five rule change proposals but three were withdrawn.

CYSA Board interviewed a PR lady at the last meeting. She was very impressive. Look for good things to come in PR and marketing. The board is taking these steps to promote CYSA.

Linda reported that she is running for 3rd Vice Chairman. Elections will be held in December.

GOOD OF THE GAME: Gary Waltz and Mountain Area League gave kudos to Linda for all of her work and participation as District VII Commissioner after which pizza and cake were served in her honor.
