**REPORTS**

**REGISTRAR:** Has been excused because of a medical emergency in Montana. Linda reported that the registrar's meetings were well attended.

**TREASURER:** No report

**STATE CUP:** The next games will be in Hanford on April 22/23. District VII needs help with the games. Nothing is set in stone for the round of 16 yet. Bill will keep you posted.

**ODP:** We are still having camps on May 21st, June 4th and 11th, and July 16th and 23<sup>rd</sup>. They are trying to change the format in order to have a better opportunity to see players. Jonathan and Joe from District III are putting together mini play days. There are scholarships available for good players who may not be able to afford the cost. If anyone wants to be on staff, please send an e-mail to the District Office. You must have a National "D" license.

**TOURNAMENTS:** The tournament directors workshop has been postponed. No date has been set as of this time. The 2006-2007 tournament applications will be on the website soon. No applications can be accepted until May 1 and must be accompanied by a copy of the draft roster.

**REFEREE:** Mick submitted a written report. He is submitting names of five referees to do the round of 16. The referee coordinator's workshop will be held at the May 10 District meeting. Reminder that if there are referees in the house leagues that are not properly dressed, he will pull them off of the field. The entry level clinics will be on the website as soon as they are processed and approved. He has six applications.

**TOP SOCCER:** They are getting ready to start. Gary attended the Top Soccer meeting in Oregon. There were 35 attendees. Utah is starting a new program and other states have shown interest. He has 106 kids playing baseball and they will continue into soccer. They are planning to put teams into McValley Cup and he is also coordinating with Special Olympics.

**COACHING:** The coaches (Maureen Aguirre-boys and Manuel Cotta-girls) represented District VII very well. There are seven courses applied for, 5 "F"s and 2 "E"s. Most are from Clovis and anyone wishing to attend may call 325-2575. Clay explained the new procedure. Only 20 books will be sent but if you have more attendees, you must contact Clay at least 2 weeks ahead of the clinic so he can order more for you. Applications must be in at least 30 days before the clinic date. There is no state policy on licensing. It is left up to the districts.

**D7PP:** Deadline for hosting games is May 1. Make sure you only apply for what you can handle. Registrars should make sure that teams are put into the correct division. The new handbook was given to all leagues. They were given the option of approving tonight or taking back to the leagues.
