REPORTS

TREASURER: The financial report for the office was in the mailboxes. There were no questions or comments.

STATE CUP: Bill reported that he and Linda along with John and Maureen attended the Regionals in Las Vegas. They saw some really good games. Some of the games were being held on artificial turf. Bill commented on how hot artificial turf gets. Thermometer showed approximately 156 degrees. The games had to be pulled off of these fields.

TOURNAMENTS: Division III rosters need to be brought into the office when applying for tournaments. If any league has a problem with teams wanting to travel, please let the office know.

REFEREE: Mick submitted a written report. The referee association is going to have a new logo. He went over the new pay scale for referees for State Cup. Referees taking the course this year will be licensed for 2008. One in-service clinic will be held in Clovis on August 17 and one in Visalia on August 20. Please make sure that referee materials are given to the referee coordinators.

ODP: Play days for the boys will be held on September 9 and for the girls on September 16. They will hold tryouts on December 1st & 2nd.

A committee has been formed to revamp the program.
