

DISTRICT VII MEETING MINUTES

May 9, 2007

MINUTES: M/S/C To approve the minutes of the April 11, 2007 meeting. Unanimous

They did OK last year although the numbers were down. She will come back in August with flyers and applications.

REPORTS

TREASURER: No Report

REGISTRATION: Catherine had 67 league and club registrars at the training session. There will be meetings on May 10 and May 17 for the registrars. District process will probably be the same. John thanked all of the registrars for attending. He was able to get the three classes that were needed for D7. He will be sending a plaque to the school for allowing us to use the facility.

RULES & REVISIONS: No report.

TOP SOCCER: Gary reported that he had been in Salt Lake for Top Soccer. He will be doing mailings for the July Jamboree.

RECREATION: The Recreation Committee would like to have e-mail addresses for all league presidents, vice presidents and registrars.

STATE CUP: Three teams made it to the quarter finals. One Fresno team went to the semi-finals. The fees for State Cup have been raised to \$500. Regionals will be in Las Vegas in June. The fees for Association Cup and Founder's Cup have also been raised.

REFEREES: Mick highlighted some of the items in his written report. Three referees participated in the State Cup quarters and semis, Scott Weston, Jeremy Fagundes and Michael Zapata. Jeremy had to withdraw. Jeremy and Michael were selected to participate at the Regionals. Seven entry level clinics have been scheduled. ODP: Next week ODP tryouts will be held at the Regional Sports Park from 5:30 to 7:00 P.M. For more information, call 977-7633. He asked that no club practices be held from May 14 through the 17th so that some of the coaches may attend. The fee is \$10. and the players will receive a T-shirt and number.

TOURNAMENTS: The tournament director's workshop is coming up.

D7PP: The applications to host were reviewed last week. Only one application came from Fresno. The out lying areas have remained the same. They hope to get the Regional Sports Park as one of the sites. Reminder that team applications are due in June and July.

COACHING: The first E/D course is full. Clay is starting to get F & E course applications. Tony Badella is a new instructor for the outlying areas. He will have an instructors orientation this weekend. Discussion was held on licensing.

COMMISSIONER'S REPORT: John thanked the league Presidents who are attending the workshop. Reedley is still missing their 501c3 and IRS proof of compliance. Valley Youth has turned in their 501c3. There is a history group from CYSA that has been formed. Discussion was held on D&O Insurance for the leagues. Cost is \$385.00. They can still use CYSA insurance but will have a huge deductible. Proof of insurance will be required for affiliation next year. Tournament paperwork requirements will be roster, 1601 forms and passes. The referee fee increase for Cup referees passed at the last CYSA meeting.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS: None

NEW BUSINESS: Mick Walker submitted a proposal for a fee increase for referee grades 7,6 and 5. Grade 8 referee fee would remain the same. After discussion the following motion was made:
