

DISTRICT VII MEETING

October 10, 2007

MINUTES

The meeting was brought to order by the District Commissioner at 7:33 P.M.

Darrellyn informed everyone that the McValley Cup Tournament was going to be held next weekend on the 20th & 21ST. The coach's check-in will be held on the 17th at the UCP Center on Ashlan and Cedar. She thanked all of the leagues for participating. She will work on the November tournament to be held in Hanford.

REPORTS

TREASURER: The financials for the last fiscal year were distributed previously. There was also a District VII Office report submitted. There were no questions.

REGISTRAR: As of October 7th, the amount of registered players in District VII is 22,839. Everyone was given a break down of registration by league.

TOP SOCCER: Games are being played at Gateway this season.

RECREATION: No report

STATE CUP: Draw will be held on the 17th of November. Everyone is welcome. Reminder that State Cup applications must be in the state office by November 1.

ASSOCIATION CUP: Deadline is November 1. We are hoping to host an age group.

FOUNDER'S CUP: Deadline is also November 1st. Be sure to get everything in early.

TOURNAMENTS: Packets for applications for tournaments have been sent out to the leagues. Red card reports must be sent to the offending team's District Commissioner immediately. Question was asked where to send red card reports on house tournaments. These must be sent to the league president.

REFEREES: Reminder that registrations are due. The charge is still \$25.00. Grades 7,6 and 5 must be sent to Mick or they will be downgraded to an 8. Discussion was held on referee pay and the games they are assigned to. Suggestion was made that we should make all coaches also be referees.

D7PP: We have a few problems and have more red cards than we'd like. The cancelled games will not be rescheduled. Particulars are on the hand-out. Please tell your teams to hold scores to 7 if the game is a blowout. Discussion was held on players playing up. Suggestion was made that we should have a rule that no player may play up more than one age group.

COACHING: Clay is looking for nominations for Coach of the Year, boys and girls.

ODP: Teams will be playing in Ripon on the 14th. Tryouts for the state will be held in December. District hopes to start in May next year.

COMMISSIONER'S REPORT: Almost every league has complied with purchase of D & O Insurance. Two leagues still do not have their 501c3 status. No response from them yet. Most of the leagues have sent in their office assessments. Leagues 6, 11 and 18 have not paid.

The CYSA Equipment Show will be held in Oakland on January 26/27, 2008. Next week John will be attending the Region 4 workshops.

John thanked the leagues and coaches for not keeping Linda in the office after hours.

Some leagues have not been attending the meetings. He will decide what to do about the situation. He will send letters to the leagues.

A short discussion was held on All Stars.

There being no further business, meeting was adjourned at 8:52 P.M.
