REPORTS

TREASURER: Short report, we are having a little problem with the bank reconciliation. When this is repaired a report can be made.

REGISTRAR: In the absence of the registrar, John asked that if there are changes to the roster for State Cup or Association Cup, please do not wait until the last minute to get it to the registrar. We must adhere to the deadlines.

TOP SOCCER: They will be giving a demonstration at the CYSA Expo. It will be held on Saturday between 11:00 and 12:00 o'clock.

RECREATION: Gary asked that we try to get as many people to the equipment show and the AGM meeting. You can check out new uniforms, etc. and attend some good workshops.

STATE CUP: The younger group will be playing in Hanford on the 19th and 20th. The draw for the older group will be held this Sunday in Pleasanton. Coaches are welcome to attend.

ASSOCIATION CUP: The games that were scheduled for Jan. 5th & 6th were cancelled. They will play this weekend in Hanford and Lemoore and next week in Ripon.

FOUNDER'S CUP: No report

TOURNAMENTS: John asked everyone holding a tournament to check on the internet to make sure that all of the information is correct before publication.

REFEREES: Mick submitted a written report. Items of interest were the new referee uniforms. The new uniforms have a new design as well as a new color, green. The old uniforms may still be worn until January 1, 2010. Rumor is that the new style uniform will be mandatory then.

A CYSA No Tolerance Policy will be handed out to all of the coaches.

COACHING: No report

ODP: Try-outs were held but lists were not available at this time.

D7PP: The league is over for the season. All the champions are listed on the website. There were quite a few fines levied for teams that did not show up for their games.

COMMISSIONER'S REPORT: All Star schedules have been sent out. There were some mistakes that were corrected. Pins and medals should be in tomorrow. When you are checking in, you must have player passes and 1601 forms.

Affiliations will be due next month. Make sure that leagues comply with 501c3, IRS and insurance.

Soccer Expo (formerly the Equipment Show) will be held in Oakland. They will have League One registration workshops, SPL, President's Round Table and various other workshops. Linda will be inducted into the Hall Of Fame on Saturday night. He urged everyone to attend.

John will be going to Pittsburg with Gary Waltz. Gary was the State and Regional winner and will be vying for the National title of Coach of the Year. GO GARY!

The CYSA Board of Directors have approved changes in the coaching clinics. The "F" classes will now cost \$650. for 15 people. Last year's cost was \$600. for 20 people. We have approximately 1000 coaches who will need licenses per District VII policy. At \$43.50 per attendee, we would be sending \$43,500. to the state if everyone attended. John will discuss the situation with Clay for the next meeting.

Outreach letter have been sent to the leagues. The D7PP gave back half of the fees for the games that were cancelled because of the bad air. All leagues have paid the fines for forfeits.

John asked the leagues that were in attendance how they would feel about charging \$25.00 for non-attendance at the district meetings.
