He gave kudos to Mick for a job well done. Mick was honored with a plaque, cards and a Harley book which was signed by all leagues and staff present. The balance of the meeting was held as a treasurer's workshop. Some important highlights of the workshop included:

- All checks must have two signatures.

- Clubs or teams should not be allowed to have their own checking account. (Must be 501c3)

- All taxes must be filed each year in order to maintain the 501c3 status.

- Disbursement forms must be used for any requested checks.

- Books should be audited each year.

Thanks to Linda! She put together a binder with pertinent information for all of the league treasurers. The binder included CYSA policies and forms that the leagues can use as a guideline.
