**REPORTS**

**STATE CUP:** The draw for the older age group was held last weekend. The draw for the younger group will be held in three weeks, the weekend of the 24<sup>th</sup> and 25<sup>th</sup>. Some of the younger groups will be playing in Hanford.

**ASSOCIATION CUP:** The U-12 and 14s played in Lemoore last weekend. They received a lot of good comments. Lemoore and Selma advanced and will play in Morgan Hill this weekend.

**FOUNDER'S CUP:** The U-12 and U-14 groups are done. U-12 boys from Clovis won. U-14 team got to the quarters but didn't win.

**TREASURER:** In the mailboxes were reports, the office financial report and the District 7 playing program financial report. There were no questions. The bank reconciliations are still not being allowed until the Accountant's changes is sent back from CYSA. No report can be made until the audit is done.

**REGISTRAR:** We are at 96 % of last year. Six leagues have over a 100% and 2 leagues have less than 50%. All registration needs to be turned in.

**TOP SOCCER:** Top Soccer had affiliated with CJSL. They have a new home and fields to play on. They are thinking about going to the CYSA AGM.

**D7PP:** All the games are over now. Bob asked that any suggestions for changes be sent to the office.

**REFEREES:** John is still searching and will let us know by the March meeting. Three referees are going to Morgan Hill to do games. He requested referees, ages 16-19, to go to Hanford as ARs.

**TOURNAMENTS:** There will be weekends available because some tournaments are going to a different organization. At the state level, they are trying to go electronic. They are also trying to eliminate one form, travel papers only. CYSA does not want dual organizations in a tournament, mainly for insurance purposes. They are trying to keep the risk down. Question was asked on rosters used for Division 4 tournaments.

**COACHING:** No report

**OLD BUSINESS :** Flyers were given out for the District 7 Spring League. This will be for the U-10/12 and 14 age groups.
