**The meeting was brought to order by the District Commissioner at 7:32 P.M.**

**John, the District Commissioner, introduced Danny Compos as the new DYRA. He commented that Danny would be capable of bringing up some of the younger refs. Welcome Danny!**

**He announced that our own Gary Waltz has been appointed as the CYSA Recreation Committee chairman.**

**John asked that changes to the league officers or directors must be sent in a timely manner.**

### **REPORTS**

**ASSOCIATION CUP:** Preliminary games were held in Lemoore. District VII had 22 teams entered. Two boy's teams, Valley and Revolution, advanced. No girl's teams advanced. Finals will be held in Danville.

**FOUNDER'S CUP:** No report

**TREASURER:** The District VII office report was in the mailboxes. There were no questions. The accountant's copy has now been received and the computer is unlocked so that the bank reconciliations from September to date can be done. The state audit went very well. Linda and Gladys will attend a Treasurer's meeting in Pleasanton on the 23<sup>rd</sup>.

**REGISTRAR:** We are up to 97 percent of last year's registration at this time. Next season we will have a one sided pass. The leagues will be responsible for many of their own player movements. They are still working on this process. Reminder that all coaches, assistant coaches, managers, etc. are required to have the appropriate license for their age group.

**REFEREES:** Danny submitted a written report. This year the emphasis will be on retention. He would like to work closely with the league referee coordinators on recruitment and training. He asked that all leagues help and cooperate.

**TOP SOCCER:** Soccer is done for the season. The CYSA Top Soccer Chairman, Ed Loss, has stepped down and the new co-chairs, Stuart and Carol Rafferty, are taking over.

**RECREATION:** A large portion of CYSA registration is in the recreation level. Gary hopes to get things going at the state and district level. He will push for pre F clinics. The conversation then turned to coaching licenses. A National D clinic will be held in Clovis in July. Participants must have an E/D license to be eligible. Please apply for F clinics early. We do not have enough instructors to do clinics at the last minute.

**D7PP:** All medals have been handed out. Next meeting the committee will be starting on next season's rules. All coaches, assistants or any team official must have the appropriate license.

**TOURNAMENTS:** The committee is working on Unrestricted Tournaments.

**COMMISSIONER'S REPORT:** There is a proposal for SPL (State Playing League) for ages U-9 and up. More information is on the web site. A survey will be sent out to all of the coaches. Please answer the survey questions. A lengthy discussion was held on the pros and cons of SPL.

The CYSA Board of Directors voted that all tournaments for U-10/11 teams must play 8V8. Spring league play will include this requirement.

District Cup medals and pins are here. Make sure that all 1601s are signed. Please check in on Friday night to make sure that all paperwork is in order.

Too many teams have fines pending. Letters will be sent out to the leagues.

**OLD BUSINESS:** None

**NEW BUSINESS:** A proposal for District Cup for next year was presented.
