

**DISTRICT VII MEETING

The District Commissioner brought the meeting to order at 7:32 P.M.

MINUTES: M/S/C To approve the minutes of the March 10, 2010 meeting. Unanimous

John announced the winners of the District Merit Awards, Bob Naugle and Bill Dearson. These are given out at the Expo but neither of the recipients were present. John presented the award to Bill Dearson. He announced that Gladys Olsen was inducted into the CYSA Hall of Fame.

REPORTS

STATE CUP: The report on the finals was put in all mail boxes. Regionals will be held in New Mexico in June. District 7 does not have any teams participating.

ASSOCIATION CUP: Richard and Emily went to Redding for the finals. The Lemoore's U-19 team and the Revolution team both lost.

FOUNDER'S CUP: No report

SPRING LEAGUE: The league has been going smoothly but last weekend there were several incidents, coaches against referees.

TREASURER: No report. We have one item under New Business.

REGISTRAR: John announced that registration was at 106%.

TOP SOCCER: The teams were invited to PELCO for Special Needs Day. They received lunch and enjoyed the day. About a 1000 kids attended.

RECREATION: September is National Soccer Month. Leagues need to send notes to Mayors and Councilman and make a big deal out of it. Call Gary at 307-9535 with any new ideas on how to promote this. Since Michelle Obama is pushing ideas on wellness and obesity, maybe we could incorporate this.

COACHING: Clay submitted a written report on the EXPO. We held a National D course and it did not go too well. We only have 4 or 5 new D licensees. Changes are being made in the course. The district's E/D course is filled but if you are interested please submit your name and the fees to the office for the next course to be held when we get 15 paid attendees.

ODP: We have a new ODP Director at the state level and the committee is extremely pro-active in the right direction. There are new ideas on identifying players. We are working on getting sponsors so that the cost is not so prohibitive.

TOURNAMENTS: CYSA has made some changes. You charge \$15.00 per team for insurance for non-CYSA teams.

REFEREES: We need applications for referee courses at least one month ahead of time. This month is the deadline for registration for 2010. There will be two or three in-service clinics this year, probably in July.

COMMISSIONER'S REPORT: There are changes happening in CYSA. They are trying to modernize. We now have a one sided player pass. Stickers for the back for the parents to sign will be available. There are a few things to work out with CAL-South for tournaments. CYSA wants to host Regionals in 2012. Registration is changing. To see great soccer, attend a professional game. John is happy with the new board. Only six attended the President's workshop. He encouraged all to attend the EXPO to be held in Monterey next year.

OLD BUSINESS: Only 8 or 10 attended the CCSL meeting held last Friday. John reported that District 2 is going into CCSL completely. Teams will probably play in Ripon or Los Banos. Clay gave a presentation on CCSL. U10 & U11 must play 8 aside. The fees including referee payment are tentatively \$385. at the lowest level, U-12 - U14 would pay \$465. and U-15-U19 would pay \$535. An explanation was given on the referee payments.
