### Field Commissioner Incident Report

The attached report must be filled out by any field commissioner who is present and witnesses any situation which happens at or about their site and, in their opinion, is disruptive to the game, is contrary to the CYSA philosophy or causes a health and safety hazard.

Examples of situations that would require a field commissioner to file an incident report may be, but are not limited, to the following:

- Excessive coaching from the sideline which appears to incite players to become overaggressive.
- Excessive spectator interference with the game.  
Comments made toward players, officials, teams or opposing sidelines.
- Players fighting after a game is over and the referees are no longer in the vicinity.
- Parents fighting physically or by word of mouth.
- Parents holding “aggressive discussions” with players, coaches, referees or other parents after the game.
- Officials who are late to games or are no shows.
- Officials who cause games to start later than scheduled without proper reason.
- Any activity determined to be unnecessary, out of line or deemed to be a negative influence.
