RE: Games cancelled weekend of Sept. 8 & 9

Given the action taken by the Playing Program Committee at our meeting on Oct. 3, we recommend that the following be posted on the District website.

All the District VII Playing Program (Don Hawkins and Harold S. Young leagues) games scheduled for Sept. 8 and Sept. 9 were cancelled due to the forecasted bad air quality. This resulted in 96 games being cancelled.

- A. **The games that were cancelled will not be rescheduled.** All remaining games (after the first weekend) will be played as scheduled.
- B. The league champion in each age group will be determined by the points as defined in the Playing Program Handbook and based on the games played (except as noted below).
- C. In some age groups, playing the remaining games as scheduled will result in some teams playing more games than the rest of the teams in that age group. If, at the end of the season, the fact that any team played more games than the other teams in the age group has an effect on the determination of the League Champion:
 - 1. The results of one game for the team with the “extra” game will be eliminated from the calculations of the League Standings .
 - 2. The game for which the results will be eliminated will be selected by a “blind draw” from all of the games played by the team with the “extra” game.
 - 3. Only the results for the team with the “extra” game will be eliminated. The results for the opposing team in the selected game will “stand”.
 - 4. League Champion will then be determined by the scoring system set out in the Playing Program Handbook.
