

Referee Administrator's Report

May 9, 2006

1. State Cup

D7 had 3 referees at the Rd of 16, quarters and semi's. The 3 were Jeremy Fagundes, Mike Zapata and Alex Juarez. All 3 scored high on their assessments.

Jeremy and Mike were invited back for State Cup Finals. Mike was assigned to the U14G final as the referee, and Jeremy was assigned an AR 2 and 4th official on a U16B and U17G games respectively. Again, both scored high on their assessments.

2. Far West Regional Championships

CYSA-N and CNRA is sending 26 referees and 5 assessors to the Far West Regional Championships this year in Boise, Idaho. 3 Referees and 2 Assessors from District 7 were selected as part of the California delegation. The referees are Jeremy Fagundes, Erick Walker and Mike Zapata. The assessors are Hunter Arakawa and Mick Walker.

3. D7 In-service Referee Clinics

Again this summer, D7 will have 3 in-service referee clinics. All referees who officiate in the D7 PP are required to attend. Those referees who fail to attend will be paid \$5.00 less per game.

Referees who officiate in the D7 PP who fail to meet certain standards will not be paid for games officiated. These standards will be discussed at the summer in-service clinics. Ignorance of the standards will not be an excuse. League assignors who assign referees to D7 PP games need to advise those referees who choose not to attend the clinics of these standards.
